



Middle School Expectations

Attendance:

- Attendance is tracked weekly using the student planner. I will ask about student attendance during conferences.
- Attendance will be recorded on student the report card.
- 5 hours of work **daily** is equal to one full day.
- 2-3 hours of work is considered a half day.
- 2 hours or less of work is considered absent.
- Community day begins at 8:45am. Please contact the SCFS if your student will not be in attendance.
- 10 days with no contact will result in your student being dropped from the SCFS program.

Conferences:

- Attend at assigned time. It is in your student's best interest to attend weekly Conference. If you are unable to attend conference please, call or email (glandin@scappoose.k12.or.us) to reschedule, if possible.
- Bring student materials. Planner, text, workbooks, questions or concerns that you as a Learning Coach need addressed or that your students needs help with.
- Conferences are 45 minutes. Please be on time. My intention is to check in with the Learning Coach, check materials, and work one on one with students.
- If materials are not presented during conference students will be given an assessment to demonstrate what they have learned over a week's time.
- STAR and OAKS are given during Conferences. Please, do not make other appointments during your assigned Conference time.

Community Day:

§ This is a time for students to come together and collaborate. Yes, it is a time to be social, however, Community Day time is dedicated to building skills and making connections to curriculum.

§ If your student would like to socialize after Community Day, please, make arrangements prior to coming to class.

§ Notify SCFS if your student plans to go home with another family or if you have made other arrangements.



Grade Policy

AT HOME Curriculum:

- Students have to weeks from the date assigned to turn in AT HOME curriculum.
- Work will be graded for accuracy and completeness.
- Complete sentences (when directed) are expected for full credit.
- Partial answers will be given partial credit.
- Math work should be shown and answer circled.
- It is acceptable for parents to correct and students to “fix” their original answer.
- AT HOME work is 40% of student’s grades.

COMMUNITY DAY Work:

- Absent students will have two week window of opportunity to complete COMMUNITY DAY work; Morning Math, Journal Entries, Essay, Science and Social Studies.
- It is the student’s responsibility to request the previous weeks work if they were absent.
- COMMUNITY DAY work is to be completed during in allotted time – not finished AT HOME, unless otherwise requested.
- Work will be graded for accuracy and completeness.
- Complete sentences (when directed) are expected for full credit.
- Partial answers will be given partial credit.
- Math work should be shown and answer circled.
- COMMUNITY DAY Work is 60% of student’s grades.

Please email / ask if you have questions of concerns. It is my hope to post student grades weekly; unless large assignments take longer to grade.



Suggested Schedule

Based upon the Mid School Community Day routine-

- 90 minutes of Math to begin the day
 - 10 minute break
- 90 minutes of Language Arts
 - 25-30 minute Lunch
- 60 minutes of Social Studies
 - 10 minute break
- 60 minutes of Sciences

Homework

At home curriculum is assigned based upon student learning level and Mid Level State Standards. At home work and workbooks do not need to come to Community Day unless otherwise requested.

Lunch, a healthy snack, and water bottle are recommended for Community Day.
